Prerequisites

Be 12 years or older

Have PADI Adventure Diver certification or have a qualifying certification from another organization)

Be trained and current for first-aid and CPR or taking concurrently Emergency First Response CPR and first-aid courses)

Confined & Open Water Dives – Candidates will learn and demonstrate the 10 rescue exercise skills and 2 open water scenarios.

Cost: Dhs2750 per person minimum 2 participants (includes PADI student crew pak,

certification processing, get credit for 4 open water dives, equipment for training, will certificate upon completion, professional instruction). Includes EFR Primary and Secondary Care. Private, ladies only and corporate rates available.
